WELCOME TO FORT LIGONIER DAYS!

There are changes to this year's celebration after last year's festival was canceled, but most of the changes won't be noticeable to visitors.

The food booths are full, but there have been some changes in the craft lots. We've changed one at the School District offices – "Train Station East" – from a craft lot to a food area, with eight to ten food vendors. One reason for doing this is that fewer craftsmen applied to take part in this year's show – possibly because of the uncertainty caused by the Covid-19 pandemic. But then we've had some late-comers, so there are plenty of crafters, food vendors, and sponsors to visit.

We have modified the detour route due to safety concerns. Traffic on North Walnut Street will no longer be able to cross West Main Street. Vehicles will have to turn right on West Main Street to exit town, whether they at going west or east. Only shuttle buses will be allowed to cross West Main Street using Walnut Street during the festival.

Festival hours will also be shortened somewhat this year, running from 9 AM to 6 PM Friday and Saturday, Oct. 8 and 9, and from 10:30 AM to 5:30 PM on Sunday, Oct. 10. There will be no evening entertainment and no Saturday night fireworks. This will help make the festival more controllable, and safer for our guests.

As for Covid-19 restrictions, all CDC recommendations will be followed.

On behalf of the entire Fort Ligonier Days Committee, THANK YOU for coming to Ligonier and participating in our event. We are thrilled to be back!

NO SHORTAGE OF FOOD FAVS AT FORT LIGONIER DAYS

Fort Ligonier Days visitors will have a new food venue this year. In addition to all the food vendors on the Diamond, a new area called Train Station East – beside the Ligonier Valley School District office building at West Main and South Walnut Street – will be completely devoted to food.

Aumer's Sausage will have a prime location at Train Station East. They've been specializing in hot sausage and sweet sausage sandwiches, smothered in peppers and onions, since they began

making their homemade sausage in 1970. Philly Steak sandwiches are also on their menu.

The Aumers are no newcomers to Fort Ligonier Days. Second-generation sausage-maker Kurt Aumer notes that Fort Days "has always been a highlight



on our calendar for at least a decade." They formerly set up in front of the Ligonier Valley YMCA, but Kurt says he's "very excited about the new location. I think we'll see a lot more of the crowd."

Uzi Kornhauser of Uzi's Pastries, DuBois, can also be found at the Train Station East location. A native of Israel, Uzi has been a pastry chef for 45 years, making cheesecakes, nut rolls,



Napoleons, baklava, cookies, sticky buns and almost everything you can think of. He sells his baked goods at many shows throughout the year but is especially looking forward to returning to Ligonier for a second time.

Also to be found at Train Station East are Crago Concessions (hot dogs hamburgers, fries, etc.), Mount Nitanee Kombucha, Ernie's World Famous Sauce, Reading



Soda Works, Cinnaroast (roasted nuts), and Muddy Mary's Gourmet (Bloody Mary spice blend).

On the Ligonier Diamond there will be several new vendors, says Vic Smith, food chairman for Fort Ligonier Days. Dark Side Roasters of Ligonier will be brewing and selling a variety of coffee blends. Michele's Lair of Loyalhanna will be offering delicious gourmet hamburgers and cheeseburgers. Royal Pizza of Greensburg will also be new on the Diamond with their pizza offerings. Roots Kitchen of Johnstown is also new, offering wraps including a taco



wrap, Mediterranean veggie wrap, a chicken Caesar wrap, etc., along with seasonal homemade soups, smoothies and fresh juice drinks.

What you won't find on the Diamond, says Smith, are apple dumplings – supplied for years by the Chestnut Ridge Lionesses. "They've all retired," said Smith, and he hasn't been able to find a worthy replacement.

"Otherwise, it's pretty much the same as always," said Smith. The Fairfield Boys Club will be back with their hot sausages; Antiochian Village with lamb and chicken gyros; Boy Scout



Troop 372 with ham barbecue, hot dogs, ham and swiss, soft pretzels and nachos; Darlington VFD with roast beef sandwiches and fries, and Ligonier Township VFD (Waterford) with haluski, pepperoni rolls, hot dogs, popcorn and cotton candy.

Other returnees include Sand Hill Berries, Patties Pastries, Out of the Fire, Laughing Crab Catering, Grandma Lamana's Stromboli and Le's Oriental. See the complete list elsewhere in the program.



NEW AREA AT MELLON PARK FEATURES DISTILLED SPIRITS AND BEER

Something new can be found at Mellon Park during Fort Ligonier Days 2021 – a new area devoted to distilled spirits and beer!

Actually, only one brewery is taking part – Sobel's Obscure Brewery of Jeannette. They are a regular at Ligonier Country Market, but not everyone knows they represent the only father-daughter brewing collaboration in Pennsylvania.

David and Jackie Sobel are the father-daughter duo. "Always ready for fun and laughter,



we endeavor to create not only a great product, but a quirky brand," says Jackie Sobel. "My father and brother started home-brewing about 10 years ago. When my dad decided to start a business, I quit my job in Tennessee and moved back home to New Stanton." In June 2017 they



began brewing, bottling and kegging commercially, establishing distribution networks in 34 counties across the commonwealth.

When the Covid-19 pandemic hit and lots of bars and restaurants shut down or cut back, they opened their warehouse doors in Jeannette for takeout sales. Meantime, they're planning to open a taproom at the location of a former department store on Clay

Avenue in Jeannette before the end of the year, with seating for more than 100, beer brewing equipment and a banquet hall. A large patio/beer garden is also planned.



The Sobels brew as many as 17 S.O.B. beers and ales, with Honey Blossom – a honey and blood orange wheat ale – being the most popular. "We do most styles but are known for light, not bitter often fruited ales," said Jackie. "But we do IPAs, stouts, blond ales and tart ales."

Jackie said she's very excited to be taking part as the first brewery represented at Fort Ligonier Days. "Our



friends at Sand Hill Berries tell us it's a great event, so we're looking forward to it."



One of the distilleries featured at Mellon Park is Stateside Urbancraft Vodka, made by Federal Distilling of Philadelphia. Stateside is another regular vendor at Ligonier Country Market throughout the summer, represented by Reed and Candice Nolan of Greensburg.

Stateside was founded by "two bored

brothers," Matt and Brian Quigley, in 2013 in their parents' basement. They worked tirelessly to perfect the perfect recipe – until their parents discovered what they were doing and kicked them out! But they persisted. Matt apprenticed at Michigan State's Artisan Distilling Program. What started as a hobby mushroomed into a business that now occupies a 6,000-square-foot facility and produces over 50,000 cases of vodka a year – plus Stateside Vodka Sodas and now bourbon.

Reed Nolan points out that Stateside Vodka is distilled seven times, certified Kosher and is gluten-free. It is also mineral-enhanced, cold-filtered and contains zero sugar and no carbs. It has become Philly's favorite hometown vodka and PA's top-selling craft spirit. Distribution has expanded throughout the mid-Atlantic region and the product lineup had also expanded.

Other distilleries participating in the special Mellon Park tasting area include Country Hammer Moonshine Distillery and Spirits of Clairton, Crooked Creek Distillery of Irwin, Disobedient Spirits of Homer City and Nomad Distillery of Williamsport.



DAVE'S COFFEE CAKE AMONG NEW VENDORS AT FORT LIGONIER DAYS

One of the new vendors at Fort Ligonier

Days this year is almost certain to be a hit – if
the long lines at the famous Shaker Woods

Festival in Ohio are to be believed.

Lou Fideli, originator of Dave's Coffee Cake, says he's seen lines 100 deep waiting to buy his nine-inch coffee cakes at Shaker Woods, where he was recruited to come to Fort Ligonier Days by one of the local organizers. "Some people bring wagons and load them up, take them home and freeze them for special occasions" he noted.



"They're pretty special. We've been doing it for a dozen years. They're all handmade and we make 75 flavors. We create the cakes and sell them up and down the coast and from the Dakotas to Alabama." The cakes have been featured at the Pittsburgh Home Show and other shows in the region and he's sold his cakes at some of the largest shows in the country – including festivals at the Erie County Fairgrounds south of Buffalo.

"I anticipate this will be a pretty good event," said Fideli, whose booth will be situated in Mellon Park. Why not with the food booths? "My cakes are like a candy you can only get rarely," said Fideli. "They are not something people open and eat on the spot. They're baked fresh and packaged so they're hard to open."

The current top seller is triple cinnamon, followed by cinnamon supreme with cream cheese. Raspberry and apricot cream cheese are the favorite fruit flavors, but there's also many other fruit flavors plus combinations like blueberry-lemon. Triple chocolate, chocolate cream cheese pecan and chocolate chip cream cheese are the top coffee cakes for chocolate lovers.

Why so many flavors? "We just went crazy! Let's try this! Let's try that! It kept improving. We try to bring our 25 best sellers to each show." Fideli was signed up for last year's Fort Days show, but when it was canceled, "I told them don't even send my money back – hopefully we can do it next year!"



The cakes are created by eight bakers at a large facility in Rock Falls, Illinois, although the business is located in Des Plaines – almost eight hours from Ligonier. Look for Dave's Coffee Cake in the Mellon Park lot along West Main Street.

A new vendor at the Municipal Lot near the Ligonier Diamond is Craig Quatman of McKees Rocks at a booth called "Get Your Jewels On." Quatman has made jewelry for the popular TV show "Two Broke Girls." He makes jewelry for both men and women using Swarovski Crystals from Austria. "They're very brilliant, shine like crazy and people love them," he said.

"I make all kinds of jewelry – bracelets I call 'cube tubes' are very popular, also corded bracelets, earrings and necklaces. I only use stainless steel or sterling silver." Quatman hasn't done many festivals but recently attended the Shaker Woods Festival in Ohio where he did very well. "My prices are very affordable and people seem to love my work."

Quatman has been making jewelry full-time for six or seven years. He worked in the vending business but was laid off in 2008. A neighbor invited him over to show him how to make jewelry. He tried it and ran with it as ideas poured into his head, and soon he was off and running – first to Michael's for supplies.

"I started putting my work on Facebook and people loved it," he recalled. He did his version of a famous Chanel necklace and a costume designer for "Two Broke Girls" saw it online and asked him to ship it overnight for an upcoming episode. The "Broke Girls" actually broke the necklace as part of the plot, but it was used again in several shows. He's since made hundreds of them and sold them all over the world.

Quatman was visiting Ligonier and sitting on the Diamond with his girlfriend some months ago when she said, "You know, this is where they hold Fort Ligonier Days." That gave Quatman the idea to apply for the show. Now he's looking forward to taking part in his first Fort Ligonier Days festival.

The Municipal Lot will also be populated by many veteran crafters including Roger Young with his huge pottery booth, Jim and Nancy Valley with their metal signs from Acorn Sign Works, Wilmer Reyes with his mounted Peruvian butterfly wings, and George and Mary Kogut with their roasted almonds, pecans, peanuts and cashews.

In addition to the Mellon and Municipal Lots, be sure to visit the crafters in three other locations – the Loyalhanna Lot just above Fort Ligonier, the Fairfield Lot along South Fairfield Street near West Main, and Train Station West near Mellon Park. For this first time in history, a dog has been named "Parade Marshal" for this year's Fort Ligonier Days Parade. But it's not just any dog – it's Daniel, the Golden Retriever, who wowed the crowds at the Westminster Dog Show as tops among his breed.

Daniel is owned by Tammy Tomlinson of Ligonier and was also star of the show when scores of Golden Retrievers (some of his offspring) visited Ligonier earlier this summer for a memorable Golden gathering weekend.

A book about Daniel was published in January called "Daniel, the Golden Retriever." It's a



hardcover picture book, written by Tomlinson and illustrated by Kiersten Eagan. It recounts the story of a "very good dog who is used to winning but learns a tough lesson" when he is snubbed by the judges for Best of Show after winning the hearts of dog lovers at the 2020 Westminster Dog Show.

This year's parade may not be as long as some in the past, but it will have all the usual elements, according to Tom Stablein, parade chairman. Something new to look forward to is the Euclid Beach Rocket Car from the Cleveland area, recalling the rocket cars that were once featured at Idlewild Park.

This Rocket Car was created from an authentic space rocket swinging ride, salvaged from the old Euclid Beach Amusement Park that existed in the Cleveland area until about 1969. Ron Heitman took a dream and did what he likes best – turned it into a car! A 1973 Oldsmobile Toronado drive train was used to transform The Rocket Car into a legal street vehicle. The original rocket frame was mated to the Toronado sub-frame. The engine is a modified 455 cubic inch Olds with an automatic front-wheel-drive trans-axle.

The Rocket Car is 28 feet long nose to tail and covered entirely with polished stainless steel panels. Along with the driver it will seat 10 adults or 15 kids very comfortably. It has been inspected by the Ohio State Police and is registered and licensed in Ohio as a legal street



vehicle. It is highly maneuverable and very smooth riding. It has a top confirmed speed of 136 mph! The Rocket car has appeared in the Macy's Thanksgiving Parade and had been featured by Goodyear at the Indianapolis 500 Race.

Of course the parade will also feature the usual contingent of antique cars, trucks and tractors, along with the fun and quirky Syria Temple Shrine units, a contingent of re-enactors



from Fort Ligonier and a fair amount of horse teams – including David Hershey's six-horse hitch.

"Nothing beats a shiny black horse in a shiny harness," says David Hershey of Warriors Mark, PA, speaking of the six Percherons from his Spring Mount Percherons farm in Huntingdon County. "Percherons are an obsession with us," Hershey added. "They have style and animation. We love taking care of them and don't consider it work."

While there will be no large university bands featured in this October's parade, there will be no shortage of high school bands. The list includes two high school bands from West Virginia – Morgantown and Philippi. Also look for Butler, Derry, Franklin Regional, Greensburg-Salem, Hempfield, Ligonier Valley – and making their first appearance, McKeesport.

The parade chairman explained that with the pandemic and lead time involved, there was not sufficient time to invite one of the big college bands this year, but high school bands aplenty have come forth to take part in the parade again this year.

"We may be short on floats," Stablein noted, because many organizations were afraid to commit, not knowing if there was going to be a parade and what the rules might be for getting together and working on a float. He also noted the Wells Fargo Stage won't be returning this year because they're not yet back on the road for parades.

Summing up, the chairman noted the parade may be a little shorter than usual – perhaps 70 to 80 units rather than 90 to 100. But he expects it will be an entertaining as ever, so be sure to find your seat along the East and West Main Street parade route when the first units step off at 11 AM Saturday. Oct. 9.



THE SOUNDS OF HISTORY

The sounds of crackling volleys and booming artillery echoing throughout town, the second weekend in October alert residents and visitors alike that something special is taking place. The firing of Fort Ligonier's 6-pound cannon and other artillery signifies the commemoration of the October 12, 1758 battle at the Post of Loyalhanna, later known as Fort Ligonier. During the fight, Pennsylvania Colonel James Burd and his men defended the unfished bastion against a force of French and American Indians, holding them at bay with artillery fire. This historic battle is the reason our community hosts Fort Ligonier Days each year – to commemorate the history of Fort Ligonier.

The Fort's cannons are part of the most extensive reproduction 18th-century artillery train in the world. Visitors to the historic site will see a faithful recreation of the artillery, wagons and carts amassed by the British army for the Forbes Campaign to take the French stronghold at Fort Duquesne (present-day Pittsburgh). The artillery train along with wagon's came from England and the colonies to traverse the rugged Pennsylvania frontier from Philadelphia to Fort Ligonier.


